Chronic Stable Angina Pectoris

Profile

- Symptomatic side of coronary artery disease (CAD)
- Manifest as chest pain and shortness of breath
- Uncontrolled angina elevates the risk of future cardiovascular events in CAD patients

Challenge



Heart Disease remains the number one cause of death among Americans¹



Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) causes ~60% of HD-related deaths¹



Angina is present in >50% of CAD patients and is often the first symptom^{1 3}




CSAP affects 11 M Americans over the age of 20¹

Stable angina symptomatic treatment annual sales in the US amount to over \$2.5 bn

Only 57% of US patients with stable angina receive chronic drug treatment^{1 2}








Proof-of-concept

AUX-001 demonstrates ≥ 18h of extended release vs. IR nicorandil twice -daily in an in-vivo dissolution profile



Single-dose, 2-sequence crossover study in healthy adult volunteers



Heart Rate response to Oral Immediate-release Nicorandil


Change in heart rate (Δ HR; mean \pm SEM) from baseline)

 sublingual nicorandil 60mg




Heart Rate Response to a single-dose of AUX-001 under Fasting vs. Fed Conditions
